Britain is not in the Eurozone, so would not have been directly affected by many of the new rules. However amending the European Union treaties to adopt the new rules would have needed the agreement of all European Union countries including Britain.

At the summit British Prime Minister David Cameron vetoed the Treaty as other countries would not agree to include protections for the City of London's financial industry

As a result other EU countries will now go ahead with the proposed rules in a separate agreement that does not include Britain.
