Methodology

Interviews were conducted online using YouGov's PollingPoint panel. YouGov uses a matched sample methodology that selects respondents to match each state's registered voter population in terms of demographics (age, race, gender, education, employment status, income, marital status, children), past voting behavior, and political attitudes (interest in politics, party registration, and ideology).
